## 2020 Vision: Intergroup Service Piece 1 of 6

Intergroup is an AA Service Office (see A.A. Guidelines – Central or Intergroup Offices) that carries out functions common to all groups. Our primary purpose is to help groups and individual members alike carry the Alcoholics Anonymous 12 Step Program of Recovery to others. To better inform the fellowship of the services we provide, we will be running a series of service pieces in 2020. The first of the series is "Volunteer Phone Coverage". We are able to provide the 24 hour hot line with the continuous support of our many volunteers. We are grateful and fortunate for the volunteers-many Intergroup offices throughout the United States use a Telephone Service where the 1<sup>st</sup> point of contact is not an alcoholic. The Intergroup phone line insures that the 1<sup>st</sup> point of contact the caller (Prospect) has is with an alcoholic who then directs them to the groups so that you can fulfill your primary purpose as stated in Tradition Five "Each group has but one primary purpose – to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers." 12 & 12 page 150.

Our 24 hour Hot Line is coordinated between our staff and several groups for weekend coverage and several individual members for week night coverage. In addition, we have several week day phone volunteers who answer the phones here at the office. This service is essential as indicated by the total number of calls; November totaled 1189 and December totaled 1159. Most callers are looking for a meeting, but when that call comes in, that they want help and can't go on living like this, the volunteers know exactly how they feel, where to send them and have insured their our own sobriety.
